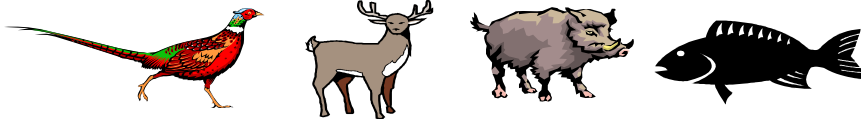


OPOTIKI BIG 3 2011

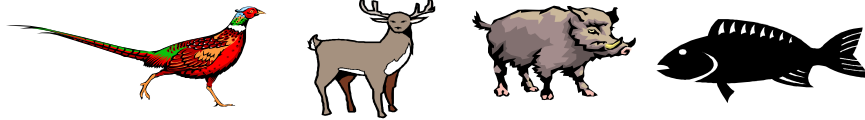
Competition Rules & Conditions



1. The competition is run over a three day period – Friday 3rd June, Saturday 4th June, and Sunday 5th June 2011.
 2. Big 3 briefing will be held at Slim’s Bar, Elliot Street, Opotiki on Thursday 2nd of June at 7pm.
 3. At least one person from each team is urged to attend to ensure rules are fully understood.
 4. Spot prizes are being drawn at the briefing on Thursday 2nd June @ 7pm and at prize giving on Sunday 5th June. You must be on site to receive a spot prize.
 5. Prize giving will commence at 5.30pm Sunday 5th June at Slim’s Bar, Elliot Street, Opotiki.
 6. Entry fee is \$150 per team of three. **Deadline for entry:** Wednesday 1st June or a \$50.00 penalty will be added to your entry after this time and date. No refunds will be given under any circumstances.
 7. Contestants enter the competition at their own risk; the organisers accept no responsibility for any loss, damage or personal injury incurred.
 8. Weigh in times are as follows
 - a. Friday 3rd, 4pm – 6pm
 - b. Saturday 4th, 4pm - 6pm
 - c. Sunday 5th, 1pm – 3pm
 9. No game will be weighed after this time unless you are in a queue and have reported in person to the official weigh master prior to the 3pm deadline. Slims Bar, Elliot Street, Opotiki is the official weigh station for the competition.
 10. All game animals must be completely gutted before weighing commences. Lungs, liver, heart and arse must be removed. If this is not done, the hunter will be asked to remove the animal and prepare it for weighing themselves – the weigh master will not do this for you.
 11. Snapper must be gilled and gutted.
 12. Pheasants must have the selected tail feather attached to the bird when presented to the weigh master.
 13. Pheasants must be shot in accordance with Fish and Game regulations.
 14. All game and fish must be presented in a fresh condition at the time of weighing. The weigh master has the sole right to accept or decline any animal, bird or fish. The decision of the weigh master is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
 15. To qualify for the main prizes for the Big 3, you must enter a wild boar or red stag / spiker, a pheasant and a snapper, the last two species being a compulsory catch.
 16. No sows, hinds or other species of deer will be accepted.
 17. The point system for the competition will be explained at the briefing.
 18. The decision to launch a boat is solely at the discretion of the skipper. All boaties are urged to comply with normal safety procedure, life jackets, radio etc.
 19. No long lines, nets or kontiki are to be used when fishing.
 20. No game to be shot from a helicopter.
 21. Teams must be confirmed by the end of briefing on Thursday. After this time there are no changes to be made to team members.
- NEW RULES**
22. Competition participants can only be entered in one team.
 23. Minimum weights will be enforced - 25kg for Boars and 45kg for Stags.
 24. At least one member of each team must have a firearms license. Checks will be conducted when weighing in animals.
 25. Team member Game Bird licenses must be presented when weighing in Pheasants.
 26. Stags that are weighed in must have no more than 12 points.
